I. BACKGROUND/INTRODUCTION

The Caribbean Resilient Economies and Sectors (RESET) Activity

The Caribbean Resilient Economies and Sectors (RESET) activity aims to lower barriers to climate and disaster risk financing, and at the same time boost investments to build resilient sectors and economies. Caribbean RESET will reduce barriers to public and private investments by incentivizing climate and disaster resilience and supporting the adoption of climate smart practices in critical sectors.

RESET will advance the goals of the U.S.-Caribbean Partnership to Address the Climate Crisis 2030 (PACC 2030). PACC 2030 is the U.S. government's flagship partnership with the Caribbean to advance climate adaptation and resilience and clean energy cooperation through 2030. The activity will focus on Antigua and Barbuda, the Bahamas, Barbados, Dominica, Grenada, Guyana, Saint Kitts and Nevis, Saint Lucia, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Suriname, and Trinidad and Tobago.

II. OBJECTIVES

The primary objectives of this session are to:

- i. Formally launch the Caribbean RESET Activity,
- ii. Showcase its offerings to potential beneficiaries, and
- iii. Publicize the details of the first Call for Proposals.

This session will also facilitate dialogue on US-CARICOM collaboration in building resilience and strengthening climate action in the Region.
